The piano accompaniment for the first system features a drum cue in the left hand and a melodic line in the right hand. The piano accompaniment for the second system continues the melodic and harmonic development. It includes two first endings. The first ending leads back to the beginning of the system, and the second ending leads to a section where the guitarist is to freeze. The chords are G7, G7, and C7.

9 *Facing down R, freeze with palms down ala "surf".* *Rock back and forth.* *Jump to face down L and freeze. Rock*

The third system contains the vocal melody for Soprano (S), Alto (A), Tenor (T), and Bass (B). The lyrics are "If ev-'ry-bod-y had an o-cean a-cross the U. S. A.". The piano accompaniment provides harmonic support with chords C7, G7, and C. The tempo remains consistent with the previous systems.
